Nothing</li> <li>Imprisonment [redacted] viewed the funeral of [redacted] in the Westgate boardroom. He visibly upset and given calls to his family to comfort him.</li> </ul>

<p><b>Tuesday 8<sup>th</sup> July</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>There have been 4 positive cases of Covid 19 confirmed in the facility, all in Medium Housing Units. All positive cases have been secured in their cells and will remain on isolation until Health Services advises otherwise. This came to our attention as inmates reported not feeling well, then being tested by medical staff. Therefore all inmates in Medium Housing and Segregation have been tested. Medium Housing is now considered to be "modified quarantine". All inmates that have tested positive have been placed on isolation in there cells, a recreation schedule has been implemented. Mass testing has been put in place for all inmates leaving the unit</li> </ul>
