March 9th	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> 3 day Lockdown: [redacted] Disrespect of unit officer. Will be placed on charge for disobeying a lawful order to return to cell.
March 11th	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> [redacted] tested positive for THC. Placed on charge.

Both [redacted] have been informed that they are on charge for the brew. Plant-like material sent out to the police.
March 21th	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 3 day lockdown – [redacted] for refusing to remove obstruction from cell observation window. • Special Search conducted on inmate [redacted] by [redacted] in Visits after receiving information about the possibility of contraband exchanged during his visit. The package contained a large quantity of tobacco and several green star-shaped pills believed to be MDMA. Additionally, a metal shank disguised as a blue pen was also found on [redacted].
