**THE BUTTERFIELD & VALLIS RACES**

**SUNDAY, JANUARY 25<sup>TH</sup>, 2026**

The Ministry of Public Works and Environment wishes to inform motorists that The Butterfield & Vallis races will occur on Sunday, January 25<sup>th</sup>, 2026, between 7:45 am and 11:00 am. The following roads will be affected:

**RACE ROUTES:** The 1k race commences on Woodlands Road in the vicinity of the Bermuda Athletic Association car park. The participants proceed North on Woodlands Road to the turnaround point located before the St. John's Road roundabout. They continue on Woodlands Road to the finish Line at the Butterfield & Vallis building.

The 3k race commences on Canal Road to the West of the Corporation of Hamilton – Works Yard Depot. The participants turn right onto Woodlands Road and proceed North. They traverse the St. John's Road roundabout and continue West on St. John's Road. They exit the roundabout at the intersection of St. John's Road and Pitts Bay Road onto Pitts Bay Road. The participants turn left onto Serpentine Road and continue to the roundabout at Woodlands Road. They exit onto Woodlands Road and proceed to the finish line at the Butterfield & Vallis building.

The 5k race commences on Canal Road in the vicinity of the Butterfield & Vallis building. The participants turn right onto Woodlands Road, proceed North, then turn right onto Euclid Avenue. They turn left onto St. John's Road, then right onto Berkeley Road. The participants proceed North on Berkeley Road then turn left onto North Shore Road. They continue to the intersection of North Shore Road, Spanish Point Road, and St. John's Road and turn left onto St. John's Road. They exit the roundabout at the intersection of St. John's Road and Pitts Bay Road onto Pitts Bay Road. The participants turn left onto Serpentine Road and continue to the roundabout at Woodlands Road. They exit onto Woodlands Road and proceed to the finish line at the Butterfield & Vallis building.

**TRAFFIC CONTROL:** The races will commence on Sunday, January 25<sup>th</sup>, 2026, at 7:45 am and are expected to conclude by 11:00 am. Police Officers and Race Marshals will be present to direct traffic along the route. All motorists are expected to use caution and avoid collisions with the race participants. Motorists are asked to follow the instructions given by the Police Officers and Race Marshals to assist with traffic control for this event.

**ROAD CLOSURES:** Woodlands Road will be closed for the duration of this event.

The Ministry of Public Works and Environment encourages the full cooperation of the motoring public and apologises for any inconvenience that may result.
