Global insurance leaders to convene in Bermuda for PwC's 19th annual Insurance Summit

Dr. Alok Aggarwal, AI visionary, Founder, CEO and Chief Data Scientist of Scry AI, and board member of Portage AI, will share insights into AI's evolving role in insurance—including the advancement of document intelligence for financial services.

- Preparing for the next climate shock and the role of prevention, data, and technology
- Managing systemic cyber risk and the role of capital markets and public-private partnerships

- Growth frontiers in life re/insurance, including asset-intensive reinsurance (AIR)
