During the search between the mattress a lighter and plastic bag was found containing brown like substance and unknown pills by [redacted] • Lockdown – Remainder of the day only inmate for being disrespectful to [redacted] in the process of a cell check. Told [redacted] "Fix my fucking phone ass." • A Special Search conducted on Rem cell #25. [redacted] cell. 1 cell phone found by [redacted] and [redacted] •
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Wednesday, October 2nd	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The sister of [redacted] called the facility to inform him that his sister [redacted] had passed away. He was given a call to [redacted] and was informed. He became very emotional after receiving the news.
Thursday, October 3rd	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> [redacted] who is housed in Max Pod 6 was secured in his cell after he was seen breaking the glass to the side of the entrance door to the Pod 6 with a wooden broom handle connected to a brush. Eleven (11) inmates were moved over to MHU E1 from Remand to make space..
Friday, October 4th	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> [redacted] was locked down for 3 days for using threatening words towards [redacted]
Saturday, October 5th	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> [redacted] was locked down for 3 days for flooding his cell and causing his cell door to hit [redacted]
Monday, October 7th	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Medical Alert for Sierra 5 cell #3 Rem [redacted] drank "African Pride Oil" bottle in front of [redacted] as she looked through the cell window hatch. [redacted] tended to him as he started throwing up. [redacted] showed the empty oil bottle and a Ban roll on bottle that was on his bed to the nursing staff. He was wheelchaired to Health Services(HS) by [redacted] and [redacted]. While in HS in stage room in HS, he grabbed a medical tool but was immediately tackled by [redacted]. [redacted] to remove the tool and handcuffed behind his back. He was escorted to KEMH via ambulance with [redacted]

- During the morning shift, it was reported that that Max Pod 3 had a leak after seeing water on the floor. The valve was shut off and _____ was called. _____ came to the Facility and checked for a leak but none was found.
- During the afternoon shift, it was reported that the entire Facility had no water. _____ was called again to assist with the problem. Upon arriving to the Facility, it was discovered that the tank had run out of water. Water was transferred to the tank and the pump was re- primed. Further investigation revealed that Works & Engineering came to Westgate on Friday late afternoon and informed _____ not to put any water in the tank in order for them to make repairs. (The repairs that they were referring to, are unknown at this time) Based on these actions, the pump lost pressure and caused the entire facility to lose *flushing and fresh water*. _____ *was eventually able to get the facility back up and running*.
