They are about celebrating Bermudian-owned businesses that serve our community, create jobs, and keep our economy moving. Each nomination represents a story of commitment, problem-solving, and growth, and we are proud to spotlight the entrepreneurs who continue to show what is possible through hard work and consistency."

Maryem Biadillah, Acting Director of the Economic Development Department, said: "The Economic Development Department is proud to continue to sponsor the Innovation and Tech Award. Every year, we look forward to celebrating entrepreneurs who are using technology to solve problems and drive progress. Members of the public are encouraged to submit nominations for businesses they believe demonstrate exceptional service, strong growth, innovation, and overall excellence. All nominees must be Bermudian or Bermudian-owned businesses, and nominations must meet the outlined criteria to be considered. Nominations close on February 15, 2026.
