Registration with a professional licensing body in medical technology such as A.S.C.P. or equivalent. Minimum of 1 year post graduate clinical experience in histology.

MEDICAL TECHNOLOGISTS - MICROBIOLOGY (FULL, PART-TIME AND LOCUM): B.Sc. degree in Medical Laboratory Sciences or Registered Technologist. Must be registered with the ASCP, HPC or CSMLS. Must have good practical experience in parasitology, mycology and serology and in mycobateria set-up and culture. Must be able to prepare culture media when required. Familiar with automated blood culture system. Minimum of 3 years of microbiology plate reading experience.
