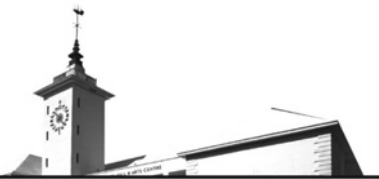

The Market Place Annual Christmas Parade **Sunday 27th November 2011**

The annual Christmas Parade will take place in the City of Hamilton on Sunday 27th November 2011, commencing at 5:00 p.m. from the corner of Par-la-Ville Road and Church Street.

THE PARADE ROUTE

The route will be as follows: Exit Par-la-Ville Car Park, west onto Church Street, south on Par-la-Ville Road, east along Front Street, north on Court Street, west on Church Street as far as the junction with Par-la-Ville Road where the floats will disperse.

NO PARKING FROM 6:00 A.M.

Parking will be prohibited in Par-la-Ville Car Park, in No. 5 Car Park (except for the disabled and senior citizens) **AND ALONG THE PARADE ROUTE**

ALSO

Par-la-Ville Road -	between Church Street and Serpentine Road
Wesley Street -	between Church Street and Victoria Street
Victoria Street -	between Dismont Drive and Wesley Street

NO PARKING FROM 4:30 P.M.

Church Street - between Burnaby Street and Parliament Street

ROADS CLOSED 4:00 P.M. FOR PARADE ASSEMBLY UNTIL THE PARADE HAS PASSED

Par-la-Ville Road -	between Church Street and Front Street
Front Street -	between Woodbourne Avenue and King Street
Reid Street -	between Queen Street and King Street
Queen Street -	between Front Street and Church Street
Church Street -	between Par-la-Ville Road and King Street
Burnaby Street -	between Front Street and Church Street
Parliament Street -	between Front Street and Victoria Street
Court Street -	between Front Street and Victoria Street

The Police are also authorized to close off any streets or portions of streets in Hamilton between the hours of 2:00 p.m. and 8:00 p.m., to divert traffic and to restrict or authorize parking as the Commissioner of Police decides.
