## **TEACHING OPPORTUNITIES FOR SEPTEMBER 2012**

The Bermuda High School for Girls, an IB World School, caters to students from Year 1 through to Year 13. The School offers the UK National Curriculum through Key Stage 1-4, the (I)GCSE examinations in Year 11 and the IB Diploma and Certificates in the final two years of school. All applicants should hold strong academic qualifications: a good honours degree in the teaching subject and a teacher training certification. Proven success, formal training and a minimum of 3 years' experience in teaching the subject(s) would be a requirement for each vacancy. A willingness to contribute to the school's extensive extracurricular programme is essential. Prospective teachers should be comfortable with the use of technology in the classroom. All applicants must meet the requirements of the Bermuda Teacher's License.
