The Authority is seeking the services of a skilled individual to work as a Senior Analyst in our Complex Institutions Department. The Senior Analyst reports to the Principal and works with a team of professionals that operate with integrity and excellence.

In this key role, you will be responsible for:

- Assisting with the coordination and execution of on-site visits of various regulated insurance entities and groups, including interactions with senior management and/or Board members;
- Developing agendas, schedules and attending prudential meetings with financial entities to discuss findings of reviews, recording discussions and decisions, and developing a corrective action plan as appropriate;
- Performing technical review and analysis functions on more complex business cases;
- Undertaking projects utilizing skills that relate to meeting the departments supervisory and regulatory responsibilities;
- Monitoring identified Companies with compliance issues by review, memoranda and timely direct follow up with Company representatives;
- Performing other related work and special projects as assigned by management in accordance with competencies normally associated with the post.
