# Secondary Department (Year 7 – Saltus Graduate Year 2) invites applications for the following posts to commence August 30, 2012.

### Teacher of Music

The successful candidate will teach Music to Key Stage 3, the GCSE Edexcel Music Curriculum and the A and AS AQA syllabi. A strong knowledge of musical technology is essential and the successful candidate will be expected to incorporate Sibelius and Cubase software programmes into the music curriculum at all levels. Applicants should be proficient keyboard players and have a working knowledge of basic audio systems together with proficiency in the use of basic Microsoft programmes. A willingness to contribute to the school extracurricular ensembles and public performances is essential and a string or choral background would also be an asset. As the sole Music teacher in the Secondary department, the successful candidate will lead the development of the Music curriculum.

# Teacher of Drama/Theatre Studies

The successful candidate will coordinate the curriculum and teach Drama and Theatre Studies to:

- · Key Stage 3 (and must be familiar with national curriculum level assessment)
- · Key Stage 4 and the GCSE Edexcel Drama Curriculum, and
- · Key Stage 5 and the A and AS Edexcel qualification in Drama and Theatre Studies.

The ability to deliver English to Key Stage 3 and/or Media Studies to Key Stage 5 would be an advantage. The successful candidate will be required to direct extracurricular drama productions and work some evenings and weekends to contribute to the Performing Arts Department.

## Candidates for Secondary Department classroom teaching posts:

- Must be qualified graduates, experienced teachers and have proven success in the delivery of their subject in a differentiated classroom at all levels of the Secondary Department.
- · Must be able to deliver their subject to the GCSE and A level (United Kingdom) examination levels.
- Must have a proven ability in the use of information technology in the delivery of the curriculum. All teachers are supplied with a laptop, and classrooms are equipped with interactive whiteboard, wireless Internet and wireless printing facilities.
- · Must be able to use an online grading system and be willing to create and update schemes of work and resources.
- · Must be licensed by or qualified to be licensed by the Bermuda Educators Council.
- Must have a commitment to the principles of independent education and be willing to contribute to extracurricular activities and the broader life of the School.

# Piano Teacher (Part time)

The successful candidate will teach piano to students at the Saltus Grammar School main campus. The incumbent must have excellent communication skills, a high level of personal musicianship and enthusiasm about music, along with the ability to motivate and inspire learners. Experience of teaching the Associated Board of the Royal Schools of Music (ABRSM) syllabus is essential and Grade 8 piano skills required. This post will start as soon as possible, depending on the availability of the successful candidate.
