Drywall Framers:

You should have a minimum of 5 years experience as a qualified and certified journeyman. You must be able to produce high quality work in a time-efficient manner. Your skills must include the following: Be able to read blueprints and other specifications, determine method of installation, work procedures, material and tool requirements to execute a project. Lay out reference lines and points, computing and marking position for framing and furring. Install track and studs, suspend angle iron and channel for ceiling and soffits, install suspended drywall ceiling grid, install structural framing and cladding.

Drywall Boarders:

You should have a minimum of 5 years experience as a qualified and certified journeyman and must be able to produce high quality work in a time-efficient manner. Skills required include measuring, cutting, fitting and installing all types of wallboard, cutting and installing metal and plastic trim. Cutting openings into board for electrical outlets, windows, vents, or fixtures, finishing corners and angles, installing vapor barriers and thermal and sound insulation.

Drywall Finishers:

You should have a minimum of 5 years experience as a qualified and certified journeyman and must be able to produce high quality work in a time-efficient manner. Skills required include cleaning and preparing surfaces, finishing corners and angles, filling joints, nail indentations, holes and cracks, taping over joints with tape and compound, sanding seams and joints. You must also be familiar with all forms of Level 5 finishing including form glass and texturing. You must be able to use and maintain automatic taping tools, use airless spray equipment, apply texture finishes and work on stilts if required.

All candidates should be able to work without supervision, have their own transport, must be punctual and reliable, must have their own tools, must be able to coordinate workloads with other sub-trades and will be expected to complete a written and practical test proving competence in their respective specialty. Basic knowledge of OSHA workplace safety rules and regulation, first aid and scaffold and hoisting experience would be an asset. Atlantic Ceilings Ltd. believes in a drug free workplace and all employees will be subject to random drug testing. Due to the secure nature of some of our work contracts you will be required to provide a Bermuda Police Clearance Certificate.
