Purpose: The Primary purpose of the Trust is to assist Mentally Challenged persons in Bermuda and to make provisions for their needs through grants and bursaries.

Qualifications:

Applicants must be:

- a. persons who assist or institutions established to assist the Mentally Challenged, or
- b. persons who are applying on behalf of the Mentally Challenged, or
- c. Persons who are pursuing or wish to pursue further education to develop their skills to assist with the advancement of the Mentally Challenged in Bermuda.

Selection:

Every application will be carefully considered although the Trust does not guarantee that every application will be granted.

The Trustees will have complete discretion in the selection of suitable applicants and will make awards accordingly.

Successful applicants may re-apply on an annual basis for further assistance to continue a project or programme for up to three (3) years.

Applications:

Applicants are required to submit the completed application form along with the names of three (3) references as well as a written statement of the intended use of the award.

The legal guardian or caregiver may complete applications for Mentally Challenged persons in whole or part.
