Key Responsibilities:

The successful candidate will be a senior member of the underwriting team of our affiliated catastrophe reinsurance investment manager. The candidate will be involved in the development and maintenance of a portfolio of collateralized property catastrophe business, with a focus on sourcing and structuring of retrocessional and indexed transactions. Working in a talented, team oriented, small organization, this position requires a combination of strong analytical, marketing and communication skills.

Specific Skill Requirements:

- Review and communicate with brokers on active property catastrophe submissions, developing pricing recommendations in collaboration with the actuarial and catastrophe modeling support, and engaging in negotiation of contract and collateral trust terms and conditions;
- Identify, develop and market innovative reinsurance solutions to generate business growth, especially focusing on retrocessional and indexed opportunities;
- Build and maintain relationships with potential clients and brokers;
- Assist in the administration and management reporting of a portfolio of collateralized contracts, including mark-to-market valuations of collateral and periodic content for investor statements;
- Effectively communicate the underwriting process and portfolio characteristics to potential investors;
- Guide the development of portfolio analysis and pricing tools;
- Work closely with the accounting, finance and claims departments to ensure reserves are set accurately and payments made as appropriate;
- Act as a mentor to junior underwriting staff.

Work Experience Requirements:

- Minimum of 7 years experience as a lead underwriter managing a book of US and international reinsurance business, including retrocessional exposure;
- Deep knowledge of collateralized contract structures and terms and conditions;
- Substantial experience interacting with capital markets investors such as hedge funds, pension funds and private equity firms;
- Proficient in the use of AIR and RMS catastrophe models;
- Extensive industry contacts including brokers and clients in the US, Bermuda and Lloyds;
- Strong marketing, negotiation, communication and presentation skills;
- Ability to work extended hours, weekends and public holidays, as needed.
