- Maintenance and renewal of financing facilities, including regular compliance documentation
- Development and maintenance of foreign currency hedging function
- Preparation of Sarbanes-Oxley and Solvency II compliance documentation, remediation processes and SSAE 16 reviews
- Maintain the functionality and administer computer based investment, banking and credit programs (Bloomberg, HSBC.net, TradeChannel, etc.)
- Oversight of securities lending program
