### **KITCHEN ARTIST**

Reporting to the Executive Chef, the Kitchen Artist must be creative, energetic and able to prepare, set up, and decorate extensive buffets, at international standards of quality and presentation, with minimum supervision within a high volume four star hotel.

Candidates must have a minimum of 5 years experience working in all areas of a large luxury hotel cold kitchen, including ice carving, butter sculpture and style foam carving. The successful candidate will have proven experience in controlling staffing, labour and costs. Schedule includes working split shifts, evenings, weekends and holidays as required. Proficiency with Microsoft Office suite applications is an asset.

### **RECEIVING CLERK**

Reporting to the Inventory Manager, the successful candidate's responsibilities will include ensuring all items delivered to the Hotel Loading Bay are accurately received and correctly recorded in accordance with hotel policy.

#### **RESPONSIBILITIES INCLUDE:**

- Ensure all items being delivered are inspected and counted in accordance with established procedures
- Record all items being received, signing documents as proof of receipt, attaching Purchase requisitions/Purchase Orders where required
- Ensure that all perishable items are quickly handled and delivered to the assigned location
- Ensure that all items received are safely secured until collected or delivered to the appropriate location
- Move and lift heavy boxes
- As goods are received assist storepersons to place goods in the store room
- Contact Department heads immediately on receipt of goods requiring direct delivery to their department
- Assist purchasing, warehouse and stores colleagues which includes delivering goods directly to various locations when time permits
- Maintain the loading bay in a consistently clean and tidy condition

#### **QUALIFICATIONS:**

- Previous relevant experience of handling goods is essential
- Previous knowledge of receiving preferable
- A sound knowledge of arithmetic
- Able to tolerate prolonged periods of standing and walking
- Superior client service skills including problem resolution
