Assistant Treasurer

Reporting to the SVP, Chief Investment Officer and Treasurer, the successful candidate will be responsible for ensuring the efficient and accurate performance of the treasury function. The role will involve maintaining and building relationships with rating agencies and banks, as well as supporting risk and capital management across the Group.

Responsibilities include:

- Maintain relationships with rating agencies, serve as the primary point of contact, coordinate data gathering processes and facilitate rating agency meetings
- Analyze impact of corporate actions on rating agency capital requirements
- Maintain relationships with the banks and serve as one of the key points of contact
- Ensure compliance with existing facilities, and develop strategy and process of establishing new credit and collateral facilities
- Coordinate with Chief Risk Officer to continuously improve credit and foreign exchange management strategy
- Work with various functions across the Group to accurately capture credit risk exposure and maintain it within established guidelines
- Execute foreign exchange hedging transactions
- Coordinate with risk team for the roll up of the Company's overall capital, liquidity and risk profiles
- Work with Treasurer on managing capital and liquidity across the Group
- Build models and frameworks for facilitating capital and liquidity decisions
- Assess financing alternatives presented by external advisors and make recommendations to Treasurer and CFO
- Work with Treasurer to develop a capital plan to efficiently match the Group's balance sheet with current and future capital and liquidity requirements
- Coordinate with Treasurer and the senior executive team in implementing capital market transactions
- Serve as a key resource for the Treasurer and the senior executive team in making capital structure and capital deployment decisions
