### **Head Coach**

The successful candidate will report to and work closely with the Association Officers. Overall responsibility will be for the daily operation of running a recreational and competitive gymnastics program with over 600 active participants/members. Duties of the position include but are not limited to:

- Coach and develop of competitive gymnasts of all levels
- Organize and arrange competitive schedules, including coordination of overseas meets, competitions and associated travel arrangements
- Manage and train team coaches and additional staff
- Provide Office/Gymnastics program administration including management of facilities and equipment
- Act as Meet Director/Meet Referee/Judge as required
- Organize/teach recreational gymnastics from beginners to pre-term level as required
- Promote continued expansion of the current national program, Bermuda gymnastics meets and summer camps

The following qualifications are required:

- 10 years of gymnastics coaching at a senior level and member of a gymnastics federation
- Professional Development Program certified or recognized gymnastics coaching certification
- Safety Certification in gymnastics
- Previous experience organizing gymnastics events

### **Coaches and a Recreational Program Director**

The successful candidates will report to the Head Coach. Responsibilities include but are not limited to:

- Teach recreational gymnastics from beginner to pre-team level
- Identifying, coach and develop future competitive gymnasts
- Coach and develop competitive gymnasts of all levels
- Manage and train more junior and/or part-time staff
- Provide gymnastic program administration
- Promote continued expansion of the national program, Bermuda gymnastic meets and summer camps

In addition, the Recreational Program Director will be responsible for the day-to-day management and administration of the BGA Recreational Program.

The following qualifications are required:

- Previous gymnastic coaching experience at club or college level
- Safety Certification in gymnastics
- Previous collegiate competition would be an advantage
- Member of a gymnastics federation

The Recreational Program Director must also have a minimum of 5 years experience running recreational programs of a similar size and nature.
