The R.H.A.D.C. is currently looking to recruit an experienced Sailing Director to lead their year-round sailing program. The Sailing Director is an important leadership position. This employee is responsible for helping to establish and oversee the entire R.H.A.D.C. Sailing Program including the Adult and Youth Sailing Programs while establishing safe boating practices. Craft involved in the program include club owned Optimists, Open BICs, Lasers, Club 420s, 29ers, J-24s, coach boats and privately owned boats. Children in the Youth Sailing Program range in age from 6 through high school. The Sailing Director is responsible for supervising all Sailing Instructor Staff. The Sailing Director will receive direction from the Sailing Committee and Club General Manager.

The Sailing Director should have extensive sailing, teaching, and leadership experience. This individual should be highly organized and possess excellent written and verbal communication skills.
