The Bermuda Monetary Authority is seeking a qualified and experienced individual to work as a Senior Analyst within the Department of Licensing and Authorisations. Reporting to a Principal, the successful candidate will be responsible for reviewing and processing regulatory requests and/or applications with respect to registered insurers, insurance managers, agents, brokers and salesman regulated in accordance with the Insurance Act 1978. The post holder will be accountable for monitoring institutions' financial performance and on-going compliance via the review and analysis of the annual Statutory Financial Return, and other confidential management information. There may also be an element of project work relating to Bermuda's insurance market. The post holder may also be required to assist the Senior Management Team in the formulation of new policies and legislation which affect the insurance industry.

This position requires a proven technical and business background. As such, the post holder must possess:

- A Bachelor's Degree in a business, accounting or insurance related field, and/or equivalent qualifications in insurance, accounting or finance from a recognized institution or professional body;
- A minimum of five (5) years' relevant professional experience in total, of which at least three (3) years in the insurance industry, and/or working experience with a financial regulatory body;
- Strong analytical, communication (oral and written) and interpersonal skills with the ability to analyze financial statements, and write and prepare reports with the view of making recommendations on the appropriate course of action;
- The ability to participate in meetings in order to execute the day-to-day responsibility of the supervision of a number of the Department's regulated entities;
- Previous experience acting as a point of contact, and communicating with industry personnel in the financial sector on a broad range of issues.
