The Authority is seeking the services of a skilled individual to work as a Senior Analyst in our Banking, Trust and Investment Department. Reporting to the Principal, the post holder will be responsible for the day-to-day oversight of a portfolio of Corporate Service Providers (CSPs), including but not limited to, on-site and off-site supervision and liaising with entities and other regulators, as required.

In this key role, you will be responsible for:

- Undertaking reviews of CSP entities to evaluate compliance with existing laws, regulations, policies, codes, plans and procedures;
 - Developing agendas, scheduling and attending meetings with entities to discuss review findings, minute discussions/decisions and develop corrective action plans, inclusive of follow up;
- Assessing and monitoring the risks to which licensed CSP undertakings are exposed;
- Evaluating and analyzing technical information and preparing reports as necessary;
- Effectively applying risk-based models in implementing agreed supervisory programmes and objectives;
- Contributing as required to the development of the Authority's regulatory policy framework;
- Liaising with licensed businesses, industry bodies and overseas regulators as necessary; and
- Performing other related work and special projects as assigned.

This position requires a proven technical and business background. As such the post holder must possess:

- A Bachelor's Degree in a relevant discipline, such as Business, Finance, Economics or Law and/or equivalent professional qualification such as CA, CPA, FRM, ACIS/FCIS;
- Minimum of five (5) years' experience in the financial services industry working preferably within the corporate services sector or with a financial services regulator;
- Exceptional analytical skills, strong interpersonal and communications (written and oral) skills;
- Working knowledge of computerized systems and databases particularly Microsoft Office Suite of Products;
- A sound understanding of financial analysis techniques, as well as risk management and corporate governance issues;
- A high degree of personal commitment and an ability to work under pressure; and
- Working knowledge of relevant international regulatory standards.
