

The Bermuda High School for Girls, an IB World School, caters to students from Year 1 through to Year 13. The School offers the UK National Curriculum through Key Stage 1-4, the GCSE/IGCSE examinations in Year 11 and the IB Diploma and Courses Programme in Years 12 and 13. All applicants should hold strong academic qualifications: a good honours degree in the teaching subject and teacher training certification. Proven success, formal training and a minimum of 3 years' experience in teaching the subject(s) would be a requirement for each vacancy. A willingness to contribute to the school's extensive extracurricular programme is essential. Prospective teachers should be comfortable with the use of technology in the classroom. All applicants must meet the requirements for the Bermuda Teachers' License.

1. **TEACHER OF PHYSICS, GENERAL SCIENCE and HEAD OF YEAR**

This position requires the teaching of Physics at the GCSE/IGCSE and the IB Diploma Standard and Higher levels. Additionally, General Science will be taught to students in Years 7-9. The successful applicant will also serve as Head of Year. Previous experience in this pastoral role would be required.

2. **TEACHER OF BUSINESS, INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY and HEAD OF YEAR**

Candidates will be required to teach Business Subjects from Years 7-9 and at the GCSE/IGCSE and the IB Diploma Standard and Higher levels. The position may also involve teaching Information Technology from Years 7 to the GCSE/IGCSE level. The successful applicant will also serve as Head of Year. Previous experience in this pastoral role would be required.

3. **TEACHER OF HISTORY, THEORY OF KNOWLEDGE and DEPARTMENT HEAD OF HISTORY**

This position requires the teaching of History from Years 7-9 and at the GCSE/IGCSE and the IB Diploma Standard and Higher levels. Additionally, the successful candidate will be required to teach the IB Course, Theory of Knowledge. As Department Head, the applicant must have extensive experience in leading a History Department that offers a range of courses.

4. **TEACHER OF BIOLOGY and GENERAL SCIENCE**

The successful candidate will be required to teach Biology at the GCSE/IGCSE and IB Diploma Standard and Higher levels and General Science from Years 7-9.

5. **TEACHER OF BIOLOGY, GENERAL SCIENCE and ROUND SQUARE EXCHANGE CO-ORDINATOR**

This position involves the teaching of General Science from Years 7-9 and Biology at the GCSE/IGCSE and the IB Diploma Standard and Higher levels. Additionally, the successful candidate will co-ordinate the annual Round Square student exchanges and involvement in service projects. Previous leadership experience would be an asset.

6. **TEACHER OF ENGLISH, HEAD OF YEAR and EXTENDED ESSAY CO-ORDINATOR**

The successful candidate will be required to teach English from Years 7-9 and at the GCSE/IGCSE and IB Diploma Standard and Higher levels. The applicant would be expected to co-ordinate the submission, marking and supervision of the IB Extended Essays. Additionally, the candidate would serve as Head of Year. Previous experience in a pastoral role would be required.

7. **TEACHERS OF ART (one full time and one part-time)**

Candidates will be required to teach Art to students from Years 7 to 9, at the GCSE/IGCSE and IB Diploma Standard and Higher levels.
