Master Electrician

The Master Electrician reports to the Vice President, Aviation & Corporate Assurance and is responsible for the installation, maintenance and repair of electrical equipment and systems at Bermuda International Airport and for the supervision of electricians and electrician apprentices. The systems include the airport ground lighting system and electrical systems associated with airport buildings. This position requires working in confined spaces and at heights. The successful candidate will ideally possess:

- Certification as a master electrician by National Electric Code (NEC) or Canadian Electrical Code (CEC) and possess NTB certification. Applicants having comparable certifications will be considered.
- A minimum 5 years of practical experience in a position of similar responsibility.
- A detailed knowledge of applicable codes of practice, and be able to interpret blue prints, electrical wiring and control system schematics, and manufacturers' literature.
 - The ability to obtain estimates and supervise subcontractors.
- A valid Bermuda Driver's License endorsed for heavy trucks, and the ability to operate an aerial lift platform.
- The ability to obtain a Department of Airport Operations Restricted Airside Pass and an Airport Vehicle Operator's Permit.

- Be competent in the use of the MS Office suite of software.
