- Understanding and communication of applications, methodologies, and procedures in catastrophe modeling and exposure management.
- Quality control and continuous improvement of the efficiency and accuracy of catastrophe processes, data collection, and reporting.
- Establish real-time tracking of and management of catastrophe risk exposures at various geographic and business unit levels using various metrics (e.g., VAR, TVAR, MFL, AAL, RDS, and Limits)
- Coordinate post-event quantifications.
- Assist in the development of aggregation techniques and models for non-modeled perils or lines of business.
- Act as a technical liaison between modeling user groups, vendors, and IT personnel.
