- reviewing, approving and reporting on valuation and pricing of proprietary Bank investments and positions
- acting as secretary to risk and investment-focused Bermuda and Group committees
- reviewing and monitoring positions and investments against governing committee directives
- assisting Group Market Risk with ALCO reporting, liquidity reports, ad hoc requests and analysis of deposits and investments
- managing dealing system limit framework (credit and market)
- monitoring market and credit risk limit regimes, alerting senior management of any departures from alignment with policy
- demonstrating and documenting ongoing alignment of the investment portfolio to stated risk appetite and management goals
- monitoring and reporting on regulatory liquidity imperatives Group-wide
- responsible for liquidity reporting to senior management and executive committees
