The Department of Statistics is seeking Survey Interviewers for its 2013 Household Expenditure Survey

Applications are invited from suitably qualified individuals for part time work as a Survey Interviewer. Persons are needed to visit households in assigned Parishes and conduct interviews for approximately 10 weeks during May to July 2013.

Applicants must be prepared to work evenings and weekends averaging 10-12 hours per week. Personal transportation is required as assigned households may cross different parishes.

Qualifications and Experience: Applicants should have a minimum of a Bermuda School Certificate (BSC) and good interpersonal skills. Preference may be given to applicants who have worked previously on censuses and surveys, and who have experience using computers.

Mandatory Training: Applicants must commit to participate in classroom training from 29 April to 2 May and 6 May to 9 May, 2013, 5:30 pm – 8:30 pm nightly at the CedarBridge Academy. Selection will be based on attendance and successfully completing an interviewer competency test that will be administered at the end of the training period.

Payment: Interviewers will be paid \$100.00 (less payroll tax) for each completed household.
