Qualifications &/ Registration required:

- American Board of Internal Medicine Certification or equivalent (e.g., MRCP).
- Successful completion of fellowship training in cardiology in a recognized training program.
- American Board of Medicine Subspecialty Cardiovascular Diseases. In the U.K. system, must have completed a minimum of 4 years of training in cardiology following qualification in internal medicine.
- Minimum of 1-3 years in the field of cardiology following successful completion of fellowship
- Current registration with Medical Council/Board in relevant jurisdiction
- Eligible to register with Bermuda Medical Council
