

CITY OF HAMILTON TRAFFIC ORDER BERMUDA ANNUAL HERITAGE DAY Friday 24th MAY 2013

THE SINCLAIR PACKWOOD MEMORIAL CYCLE RACE AND IN-LINE SKATERS RACE (through City) Entering Front Street at the Eastern City Boundary in a westerly direction to the junction of Queen Street, north on Queen Street, east on Church Street, and north on Cedar Avenue. The finish line for the cyclists will be on Cedar Avenue outside the Leopards Club. The in-line skaters will continue north on Cedar Avenue to the City Boundary and will finish on Dutton Avenue adjacent to Bernard Park.

<u>JUNIOR CLASSIC</u> (<u>starts in City</u>) Commences at 9.30 a.m. at the eastern end of Front Street in an westerly direction to the junction of Queen Street, then north on Queen Street, east on Church Street, north on King Street, west on Victoria Street and north on Cedar Avenue to the City Boundary.

MARATHON DERBY (through City): Same route as for the Junior Classic. Starts at 9:00 a.m.

<u>PARADE ROUTE</u> Starts at 1.30 p.m. at Dutton Avenue to Marsh Folly, west to St. John's Road, south (Cedar Avenue) to Church Street, east to Court Street, south to Front Street, west to Queen Street, north to Church Street, east to Dismont Drive. Ending at City Hall Car Park.
