North American Optimist Regatta Parade

Motorists are advised of a temporary disruption of traffic to allow the North American Optimist Regatta Parade to proceed from Albuoy's Point to Queen Elizabeth 11 Park.

The parade will start at Albuoy's Point and proceed north on Point Pleasant Road past the Ferry Terminal and eastbound on Front Street then turn north onto Queen Street and finish at the Queen Elizabeth 11 Park. The Bermuda Police Service will hold traffic at various intersections to allow the parade to pass uninterrupted.

The parade will consist of competitors of the regatta representing **20** countries.
