- Assist with the management and training of other coaches and staff members;

- Administer Demosphere (the BGA's web-based administration system), and the BGA website;
- Assist with facilities and equipment management;
- Promote the continued expansion of the national program, Bermuda gymnastics meets, and recreational camps;
- Organize and teach recreational gymnastics from beginners to pre-term as required; and
- Assist the Head Coach with other projects and tasks as required.

The following qualifications are required:

- A minimum of 6 years coaching experience, at least 3 of which are at a senior level;
- Membership in a gymnastics federation;
- Professional Development Program certification or a recognized gymnastics coaching certification;
- Safety certification in gymnastics; and
- Previous experience organizing gymnastics events.
- Previous collegiate gymnastics competition experience would be an advantage.
