The primary purpose of the role is to underwrite and manage a portfolio of business in accordance with the business plan and the guidelines determined by the Amlin AG Board of Directors.

Key Responsibilities:

- Quote, underwrite, service and process the International Catastrophe, Risk XL and Accident & Health accounts as per the Amlin Bermuda Underwriting Policies and Guidelines as modified from time to time;
- Involvement in Amlin Bermuda's RDS on a quarterly and ad hoc basis;
- Involvement in retrocessional purchasing in conjunction with the Leading Class Underwriter and CEO;
- Management responsibility for one Technical Assistant;
- Deputise for the Leading Class Underwriter and other Class Underwriters as required and expressly authorised;
- Maintain a suitable working knowledge of all classes of business;
- Analyse market and target potential new clients, brokers and products;
- Maintain and build relationships with existing clients and brokers through visits, entertainment and conferences.
- Monitor market developments and assist in the construction of annual income and profit plans for classes of business;
- Review a broad cross section of risks, quotes and endorsements within assigned parameters;
- Check renewals regularly and review by exception;
- Review underwriting figures on a regular basis in order that unusual trends, data integrity issues, and / or adverse movements may be dealt with by appropriate action; and
- Remain alert to developments affecting the business of Amlin Bermuda, the potential profitability of Amlin Bermuda and opportunities for Amlin Bermuda, and to report on such matters, as appropriate, to the Leading Class Underwriter and CEO.

Minimum Qualifications, Skills and Experience:

- Possession of an industry related certification is required preferably CPCU or ACII
- Minimum of 10 years underwriting experience working within the London and Bermuda Insurance market
- Existing good working relationships with both clients and brokers worldwide
- Detailed and extensive working knowledge of International Catastrophe, Risk XL and Accident & Health accounts
- Must have hands on portfolio control experience including the design and implementation of technical rating and catastrophe aggregation systems
- Well developed business and social skills and capabilities for strengthening client / broker relationships
