

# TEACHING VACANCIES REQUIRED FOR DECEMBER 2013

The Bermuda High School for Girls, an IB World School, caters to students from Year 1 through to Year 13. The School offers a modified English National Curriculum through Key Stages 1-3, the GCSE/IGCSE examinations in Years 10 and 11 and the IB Diploma and Courses Programme in Years 12 and 13. All applicants should hold strong academic qualifications: a good honours degree in the teaching subject and teacher training certification. Proven success, formal training and a minimum of 3 years' experience in teaching the subject(s) at the GCSE/IGCSE and IB Diploma levels would be a requirement for each vacancy. A willingness to contribute to the school's extensive extracurricular programme is essential. Prospective teachers should be comfortable with the use of technology in the classroom. All applicants must meet the requirements for the Bermuda Teachers' License.

## 1. Teacher of Information Technology, Business Subjects and SIMS Coordinator

Candidates are sought to teach Information Technology and Business Subjects throughout the Secondary age range including a modified English National Curriculum Key Stage 3, the GCSE/IGCSE and the International Baccalaureate Higher and Standard Levels. This position also involves the strategic school-wide development and coordination of SIMS, an information management system. Candidates must be able to demonstrate a comprehensive knowledge of SIMS, troubleshoot technical issues and facilitate SIMS training for all stakeholders.

## 2. Teacher of Chemistry, Science and Environmental Systems and Societies

Candidates are sought to teach Science across the 11-14 age range, GCSE/IGCSE Chemistry, IB Standard and Higher Level Chemistry. Experience in teaching IB Environmental Systems and Societies would be an advantage.
