THE ROAD TRAFFIC ACT 1947

THE ROAD TRAFFIC (VARIATION OF SPEED LIMITS)
(No. 9) ORDER 2013

In exercise of the power conferred upon the Minister charged with responsibility for Works by Section 7(2A) and (2B) of the Road Traf- fic Act, 1947, the following Order is hereby made:-

1. (i) This Order may be cited as the Road Traffic (Variation of Speed Limits) (No.9) Order 2013.

(ii) This Order applies to the contestants and to the attendant vehicles to the contestants of the Bermuda Bicycle Association Team Tokio Time Trial Bicycle Race on the Bermuda Land Development Company and Ministry of Public Works roadways to be held on Sunday 6th October, 2013.

2 (i) The speed limits fixed by Section 7(2) of the Road Traffic Act, 1947 are hereby varied to the extent specified in the first column of the Schedule in respect of the Bermuda Bicycle Association Team Tokio Time Trial Bicycle Race.

(iii) The roads or parts thereof specified in the second column of the Schedule are hereby declared to be subject at the times specified in the third column of the schedule to the speed limit specified in the first column thereof.

SUNDAY 6TH OCTOBER, 2013

Cycle Race: Route

The start/finish Cooper’s Island Road in St. David’s (by Clearwater Beach), head up to the roundabout and up Pepper Hall Road, left on Tommy Fox Road, continue on Southside Road, turning right at the roundabout onto Lower Gate Road then left on to St. David’s Road. St. David’s Road through the roundabout onto Kindley Field Road to the airport roundabout and turn back on Kindley Field Road heading to St. David’s. Continue on St. David’s Road all the way to Texas Road, turn right on Texas Road, right to Orange Hole Road and left on Pepper Hall Road. Then straight down Cooper’s Island Road to the finish line adjacent to the start line.

TRAFFIC CONTROL: The bicycle race will commence on Sunday 6th October, 2013 at 7:30am and is expected to be concluded by 09.30 am. All motorists are expected to use caution and avoid collusion with race participants. The race route will be under Race Official control. Motorists are asked to follow Race Official instructions to assist with traffic control for this event.

ROADS CLOSED: There will be no roads closed to traffic while this bicycle race takes place but motorists are asked to use caution. They must also allow cyclists to participate and give way when directed by Race Officials.

PARKING: There will be no parking restriction for this bicycle race but motorists are permitted to park in designated parking bays along any part of the race route. Additionally motorists must not block the race route or impede the participants in the bicycle race.

In addition, the Bermuda police are hereby authorized to “Close-Off” streets or portions of streets and authorize parking as the Commissioner of Police decides.
