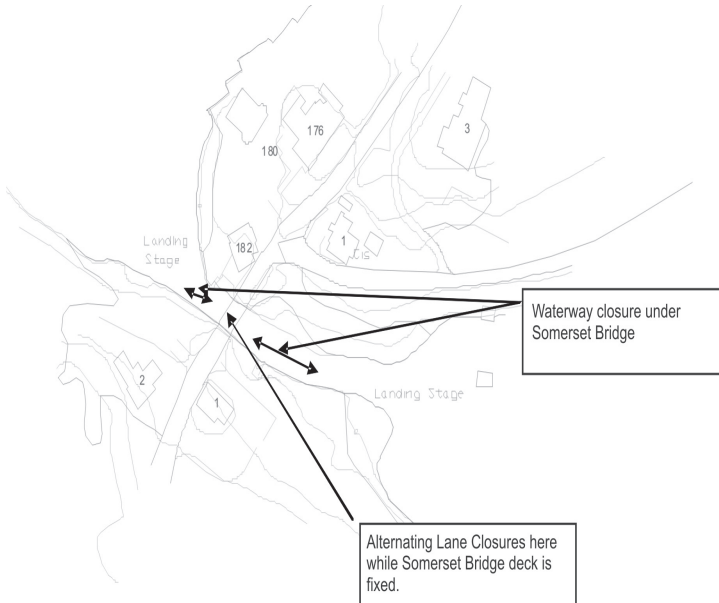
**SOMERSET ROAD AT SOMERSET BRIDGE**

This Ministry wishes to inform motorists that a lane on Somerset Road will be close to traffic. The alternating lane closures are necessary so this Ministry road maintenance crew can repair the wooden deck across Somerset Bridge.

To accommodate traffic movement on the open traffic lane, there will be traffic signals and when necessary Stop and Go Boards are to be used to control the traffic flow if the crew needs to remain on site longer.

Only one lane at time will be open to accommodate traffic flow, and this will take place at 9 am and we are schedule to have both lanes open at 3pm on each day the works are carried out.

To achieve access to the underside of the Somerset Bridge deck, the water way under Somerset Bridge will be closed to all marine traffic during our schedule works.
