



Teaching Vacancies

Warwick Academy is an I.B. World School catering to students from Year 1 through to Year 13. The school offers the UK National Curriculum through Key Stage 1 – 4, the GCSE/IGCSE examinations in Year 11 and the IB Diploma and Certificates in the final two years of school. All applicants should hold a good honours degree in the teaching subject or a closely related subject, a teacher training certification and be prepared to contribute to the school's extensive extra-curricular programme.

1. Teacher of English Language and English Literature

A teacher is sought to teach English Language and Literature throughout the 11-18 age range, including the UK National Curriculum Key Stage 3, IGCSE, and International Baccalaureate Higher and Standard levels. The ability to teach Drama to Key Stage 3 and assume responsibility for the Debate Team would be an advantage.

2. Teacher of Design & Technology and Head of Practical Arts Department

A teacher is sought to teach Design & Technology throughout the 11-18 age range including the UK National Curriculum Key Stage 3, the IGCSE and International Baccalaureate (Standard & Higher levels). The ability to offer graphics at IGCSE level is essential. This position also includes a responsibility as Head of Department.

3. Teacher of English Language and English Literature, and Head of Year

A teacher is sought to teach English Language and Literature throughout the 14-18 age range, including IGCSE, and International Baccalaureate Higher and Standard levels. This position also includes a responsibility as Head of the Sixth Form. Knowledge and experience of international university application procedures and admissions requirements is essential. This post involves playing a full part in the School's Strategic Team and periodic relationship to the Board of Governors and sub-committees.

4. Teacher of Chemistry and Science

A teacher is sought to teach Chemistry throughout the 14-18 age range, including IGCSE, and International Baccalaureate Higher and Standard levels. A contribution to United Kingdom National Curriculum Key Stage 3 General Science at ages 11-14 is also required.

5. Teacher of Spanish and French

A teacher is sought to teach Spanish throughout the 11-18 age range including Key Stage 3, IGCSE and International Baccalaureate Higher and Standard levels, and French to United Kingdom National Curriculum Key Stage 3 and IGCSE.

6. Teacher of History

A teacher is sought to teach History throughout the 11-18 age range, including United Kingdom National Curriculum Key Stage 3, IGCSE, and International Baccalaureate Higher and Standard levels.

7. Teacher of English Language and English Literature

A teacher is sought to teach English Language and Literature throughout the 11-18 age range, including United Kingdom National Curriculum Key Stage 3, IGCSE, and International Baccalaureate Higher and Standard levels.

8. Teacher of Mathematics and Head of Year

9. Head of the Primary Department

Applicants should have a full understanding and experience of the UK National Curriculum Key Stages 1-3 as well as familiarity with international curricula and qualifications. Applicants should have a proven track-record in school leadership, mentoring and development of staff, a detailed knowledge of the Early Years Foundation Stage, and associated assessment strategies of the United Kingdom National Curriculum. As Warwick Academy is an International Baccalaureate Organization school, a broad knowledge of international educational trends and knowledge is essential to this role. Knowledge of the I.B. and experience in another IBO school would be a great advantage to anyone applying for this position.

Applicants should hold a Bermuda Teachers' License, be able to show recent and relevant experience in the educational programmes offered at Warwick Academy (UK National Curriculum, IGCSE, and International Baccalaureate) and be able to relate positively to students, teaching staff and parents. The above posts require experience of teaching this curricula and proven success at external examinations is essential.
