CLINICAL MANAGER

Key responsibilities include:

- Coordinates activities of the team and promotes a multidisciplinary approach to patient care within Mental Health Services. Supervises the professional and ancillary staff in the application of advanced mental health clinical knowledge and skills in accordance with established policies and procedures
- Makes patient rounds, receives and submits reports to monitor continuity of care. Also functions as a resource person and ensures the orientation of all new staff of unit policies, procedures and standards
- Assists with the development of the annual unit budget, monitors the approved budget and oversees payroll applications. In addition, maintains administrative records, while compiling/preparing statistics and reports as required
- Partners with community agencies for the provision of information, health education and counseling to individuals, families and community groups about mental health, disease prevention, health promotion and health maintenance
- Supports the implementation of new services, care teams and participation on committees and various activities/ projects, as required

- Graduate of a Registered Nurse Education Programme approved by the Bermuda Nursing Council preferred or any other Masters' prepared professional with experience in managing psychiatric services
- Current registration with the Bermuda Nursing Council or professional body, as required
- Minimum of 3 years post graduate experience as either a Nurse Manager or a professional in Behaviour Sciences - working with mental health service users - both skilled and independent

EDUCATION THERAPIST

CHILD & ADOLESCENT SERVICES (MID-ATLANTIC WELLNESS INSTITUTE)

Key responsibilities include:

- Liaises with school counselors and other educational staff to determine the child's level of academic function and to secure appropriate course material
- Provides academic supervision and guidance to students while in the Day Hospital
- Assists with the identification and remediation of behavioural deficits and excesses which impact interaction with the environment or adversely affect community placements
- Drafts behavior management plans/interventions based on client needs
- Works in collaboration with the Outpatient clinical team during the service user's transitional phase
