Treaty Underwriter –North America

Our client...MS Frontier Reinsurance Limited is a reinsurance company domiciled in Bermuda, specializing in Reinsurance on a global basis. MS Frontier Re is a member of MS & AD Insurance Group (MSAD), one of the largest general insurance groups in the world.

Due to continued business growth, the Company is looking to hire a Treaty Underwriter who will report to the Executive Underwriter – North America to execute, manage and grow, the North American portfolio.

Core responsibilities will include, but not be limited to the following:

- Work with the Executive Underwriter in order to achieve company profitability targets by underwriting and actively managing opportunities, reflecting market conditions;
- Assist in coordinating the underwriting team activities, in order to achieve set goals;
- Analyze, evaluate and provide input with respect to reinsurance submissions for North American clients;
- Assist the Executive Underwriter in developing and maintaining a well- balanced, profitable portfolio by deploying aggregates in an efficient manner;
- Assist the Executive Underwriter in planning and executing North American team marketing strategy, in order to continually develop the portfolio;
- Provide general guidance across the organization by assisting other departments with queries relating to premiums, claims and/or aggregates pertaining to North American programs;
- Maintain awareness and knowledge of developments in the North American reinsurance market place and assist the EU in analyzing and reporting such developments to upper management;
- Meet with clients and brokers, in Bermuda and abroad, as necessary;
- Assist with Open CO+ entries for North American business and ensure data integrity. Make system upgrade recommendations as necessary;
- Prepare and review data for management reports and presentations;
- Monitor and update workflow process to ensure team efficiency; and
- Assist in reviewing Catastrophe models licensed by MSFRE, with a view to maximizing the benefits of each tool.

The role of Treaty Underwriter – North America is a challenging position requiring proven technical and operational capabilities. The successful candidate will need to demonstrate the following required skills and experience:

- Educated to at least Bachelor's degree level in business, finance, or related quantitative discipline;

- Industry professional designations, such as CPCU and/or ARe will be required;
- A minimum 7 – 10 years of reinsurance underwriting and/or broking experience concentrated in the North American reinsurance markets;
- A minimum of 7-10 years experience underwriting and/or broking all types of Property reinsurance as well as Personal Accident, Workers Compensation and Casualty reinsurance;
- Exhibit robust understanding and experience with portfolio management and analysis in order to improve underwriting and maximize profitability;
- Demonstrate strong knowledge and experience of current developments in the North American reinsurance markets on a regional, national and global basis; which will be examined as part of the selection process;
- Candidate is expected to produce new business opportunities and sources of income
- Experience in international markets is advantageous;
- Strong understanding of dynamic financial analysis modelling for accumulation and pricing purposes;
- Proven knowledge of US primary insurance forms and products;
- Capable of interacting effectively with clients and brokers and represent the company on one-on-one basis locally and overseas, as necessary;
- Robust verbal and written communications ability is required; and
- Expected to work overtime and weekends at peak renewal times

Due to the importance and profile of this position, shortlisted candidates could be required to undertake psychometric testing as part of the selection process.

Remuneration will be commensurate with the experience.


