Kite Safety Rules

Always use the correct supplies when making a kite.

Keep your kites away from power lines and busy roads.

Only fly your kites in safe places, such as beaches, fields and playgrounds (away from overhead power lines).

Only fly your kites on bright, sunny days.

If your kite gets caught in power lines, don't tug on the tail or pull the string.
