The successful applicant will have to demonstrate a vibrant personal faith and a gifting in evangelism. The individual must be a well-regarded teacher with a high view of Scripture. The successful applicant will be willing to assist the Incumbent with sacerdotal duties and administration of the Parish. The individual will be expected to be a person of prayer who desires to grow in personal faith while helping others grow in their faith. The successful applicant will be skilled in congregational development, able to work without close supervision, and comfortable with traditional Anglican worship and experimenting with new ways to reach people in Bermuda. The successful applicant will have a passion for church growth, and will be excited about growing the faith of our congregants and enabling them to spread the Good News of Jesus Christ. The ideal candidate would also have experience in working with youth and children and across racial lines.

The Associate will have special responsibility in working under the direction of the Incumbent to oversee and develop the mission and ministry of St. Monica's and St. Augustine's Churches. The individual will be expected to nurture the current congregation while growing these churches in both numbers and commitment to the Gospel. To perform these duties, the Associate must be excited about immersing themselves in those communities and must be an "outside-the-box" thinker, collegial leader, and unafraid of experimenting with new ways to spread the gospel.

Every applicant will need to supply a current resume (CV) with photograph; a video or tape recording of a recent sermon; references from your current position, your current Bishop and a lay person; and a two page letter giving testimony to your faith and outlining your gifts and skills that make you the right person for the position.
