INTERNATIONAL SANCTIONS (SUDAN AND SOUTH SUDAN)
AMENDMENT REGULATIONS 2014

BR 86 / 2014

The Minister responsible for justice, in exercise of the power conferred by section 2 of the International Sanctions Act 2003, makes the following Regulations:

Citation

1 These Regulations which amend the International Sanctions Regulations 2013 (the principal Regulations) may be cited as the International Sanctions (Sudan and South Sudan) Amendment Regulations 2014.

Amends Schedule 1

2 Schedule 1 to the principal Regulations is amended by revoking paragraphs (d) and (o) and inserting after paragraph (zc) the following—

“ (zd) The Sudan (Sanctions) (Overseas Territories) Order 2014

(ze) The South Sudan (Sanctions) (Overseas Territories) Order 2014

”.
