Teacher of Geography

We are looking for a dynamic geography specialist, with proven examination success and experience of teaching at the International Baccalaureate or A Levels, IGCSE and UK National Curriculum Key Stage 3, to be the lead teacher in this popular subject. This post includes a Head of Year middle management position within the pastoral structure of the school and the candidate must have suitable experience to be able to function in this position. In addition experience leading the Duke of Edinburgh programme will be viewed favourably.

Teacher of Business Studies, Geography and Environmental Systems/Examination Officer

A teacher is required to teach Business Studies to IGCSE, Business Management to IB Higher and Standard levels, and Environmental Systems and Societies to IB Standard level. Some Geography teaching in Key Stage 3 years will also be required. This position will include whole school responsibility for internal and external examination coordination and experience working with international examination boards is required.

Teacher of Physical Education (Secondary girls)

A teacher is sought to be responsible for girls' physical education within the Secondary Department and the teaching of IGCSE and A Level or BTEC Physical Education/Sport options. For the A Level or BTEC the successful applicant will be the lead teacher in addition to having a coaching responsibility for all secondary girls' sports teams both during and after the school day.

Teacher of Physics

A teacher is required to teach Physics across the secondary curriculum to Key Stage 3, IGCSE and Higher and Standard Levels at the International Baccalaureate. Experience of and examination success in the teaching of Physics to GCSE/IGCSE and IB/A Level are essential. The successful applicant will be the lead Physics teacher in the Science Department and will be expected to assist with the promotion of science in the school.

Applicants should hold a Bermuda Teacher's License, be able to show recent experience in the educational programmes offered at Warwick Academy (UK national Curriculum, IGCSE, and International Baccalaureate) and be able to relate positively to students, teaching staff and parents.
