General Responsibilities

- Be able to describe and communicate the value of a project, initiative or activity in terms of both its benefits and costs in language used by the business community that will effectively obtain leadership understanding, support and approval
- Assess challenges and questions from multiple viewpoints and present options for solutioning a problem taking into account time, cost, risk, likelihood of success and the impact of change
- Elicit requirements utilizing interviews, document analysis, requirements workshops, surveys, site visits, business process descriptions, use cases, scenarios, business analysis, task and workflow analysis
- Critically evaluate information gathered from multiple sources, reconcile conflicts, decompose high-level information into detailed requirements, abstract up from low-level information to a general understanding, and distinguish user requests from the underlying true needs
- Proactively communicate and collaborate with external and internal customers of Information Technology to analyze information needs, functional requirements and facilitate the delivery and documentation of the following artifacts as needed:
 - Functional requirements
 - Business requirements
 - Use cases, GUI, screen and interface designs
 - Test plans, scenarios, cases and conditions
 - Quantitative and Qualitative Business cases

The successful applicant must have:

- A Bachelor's Degree in Business Administration / Business Management is preferred or equivalent work experience
- A minimum of 7 years Business Analysis or Consulting experience in a Financial Services organization with at least 5 years in Investment Banking
- A minimum of 10 years experience working hands on with Investment or Trust systems plus 1 of the following: Core Banking, Internet Banking, CRM systems
- Knowledge of integration into Core Banking (preferably Fiserv) applications essential
- Demonstrated ability to lead teams by providing coaching, guidance, encouragement, feedback and overall support
- A deep understanding of systems engineering concepts
- Good judgment in identifying issues and recommending solutions to others
- Demonstrable experience across banking and investment channels
