Notice is hereby given that in connection with the staging of the K.P.M.G. Invitational Mile running races, and a Musical Display by the Bermuda Regiment Band and the Bermuda Islands Pipe Band, being held on the above date, the following traffic restrictions will be in effect in Hamilton:

ROADS CLOSED

Front Street:

Between Par-La-Ville Road and the foot of Spurlings Hill will be closed to all vehicular traffic from 6:00 pm and will re-open at 11:00 pm

Burnaby Street:

Between Reid and Front Streets will be closed to all vehicular traffic from 6:00 pm and will re-open at 11:00 pm

NO PARKING

Front Street:

Between Par-La-Ville Road and the foot of Spurlings Hill between 4:00 pm and 11:00 pm

Patrons of businesses along Front Street East are reminded that **ALL VEHICLES MUST BE PROMPTLY REMOVED FROM THAT SECTION OF FRONT STREET BY 5:00 pm**

Burnaby Street: Between Reid and Front Streets from 4:00 pm until 11:00 pm

No. 1 Car Park:

No parking after 2:00 pm, gates will be locked at 5:00 pm and will not open until 11:00 pm

No. 5 Car Park:

No parking after 2:00 pm, access will be closed at 5:00 pm and will not open until 11:00 pm

The Bermuda Police are hereby authorized to close-off streets or portions of streets, restrict and authorize parking as the Commissioner of Police may decide.
