



## **CAREGIVERS**

These positions attract hours that vary according to each client. The successful candidate must be willing to live in or live out and to work nights, weekends and holidays to meet the needs of our senior and/or disabled clients.

You must possess:

- A Qualification in Nursing;
- And/or a Nurse Assistant qualification or equivalent;
- Minimum of 3 years recent experience in similar roles;
- Up to date CPR certification;
- Good written and verbal skills; and
- A clean Police Report.
