The Minister of Finance, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 12 of the Government Employees (Health Insurance) Act 1986, makes the following Order:

Citation and commencement

1 (1) This Order may be cited as the Government Employees (Health Insurance) (Rates) Amendment Order 2015.

(2) This Order shall come into operation on 1 April 2015.

Revokes and substitutes Part A of Schedule

2 The Schedule to the Government Employees (Health Insurance) (Rates) Order 2001 is amended by revoking Part A and substituting the following—
