Responsibilities will include but are not limited to:

- Oversee and responsibility for the Group Consolidation process and systems and personnel;
- Assist subsidiary teams where required in preparation and review of sub consolidations and financial statements;
- Assist the Corporate Controller in monitoring consistency of Group Finance Policy and processes across the Group;
