Approved container 2

An approved container for the purpose of receiving samples

of blood, urine or other bodily substances under sections 35C to 35H

of the Road Traffic Act 1947 is a specimen container that contains no

less than 100 milligrams sodium fluoride together with 20 milligrams potassium oxalate in 10 millilitres of blood, urine or other bodily fluids

and drug analyses.
