

Are you unemployed? Do you have a job? Are you in temporary or permanent employment? Do you have health insurance?

The Department of Statistics will collect information on these important topics through its annual Labour Force Survey. This survey is designed to collect data on employment, unemployment, and other key characteristics of the labour market. Data collected will be used to determine the profile of Bermuda's workforce and assist with developing labour policies. Bermudian and non-Bermudian households will be randomly selected to participate in the survey.

How will this be done?

- The survey will be conducted during the months of May and June 2015.
- Letters have been mailed to households that were randomly selected to participate with an invitation to make an interview appointment.
- A telephone interviewer representing the Department of Statistics will call to administer a brief questionnaire.

The Labour Force Survey is conducted under the authority of the Statistics Act 2002 which requires selected households to provide the necessary information. The Act also safeguards the confidentiality of every respondent and requires that the information be used only for the purpose of compiling summary statistics.
