The Analyst works under the supervision of the Head of Analysis of the Financial Intelligence Agency to collate, categorize, prepare and disseminate information relative to actual and anticipated financial criminal, money laundering and terrorist financing activity.

The successful candidate for the role of Analyst will be required to demonstrate the following:

- Possess a minimum of 3 years practical experience in either financial investigations, banking, accounting, auditing, Anti-Money Laundering/Compliance, intelligence gathering or any combination of the aforementioned;
- Ability to analyze problems, identify significant factors, gather pertinent data and produce solutions;
- Plan and organize workload and have proficient oral, writing and computer skills.
- Capable of working independently, setting priorities and meeting deadlines, be energetic, conscientious, highly motivated with a high degree of self confidence and able to work on own initiative.
- Demonstrative ability to work with a variety of people in a team orientated environment.
- Work well under pressure and display adaptability to change in a highly confidential environment.
- Honesty and integrity are critical to the post.
- Capable of working within a computerized environment and proficient with various Microsoft applications including but not limited to Word, Power Point and Excel.
- Proven knowledge and practical experience in the use and management of software that is capable of financial analysis, suspicious activity monitoring, watch-list filtering and case management is required.
