ORACLE TEAM USA ("OTUSA"), the sailing team defending the 35th America's Cup in Bermuda, is seeking an experienced IT Coordinator to join the OTUSA team at the Royal Naval Dockyard in Bermuda. The successful candidate will be responsible for assisting the IT Manager of the America's Cup Event Authority, the entity responsible for the commercial and event management of the 35th America's Cup, with the provision of information technology services and support to both OTUSA and ACEA in respect of the 35th America's Cup.

This position presents the successful candidate with an excellent opportunity to build upon existing IT experience, whilst playing a valued role in the planning and staging of a world-class sporting event in a fun, challenging and dynamic work environment. Conditions of employment will reflect the responsibility of the position. This is a full time, salaried position. Bermudians are encouraged to apply.

Essential Responsibilities:

- Report to the IT Manager of ACEA and OTUSA.
- Based in OTUSA's team base at the Royal Naval Dockyard.
- Provide services and support for a Windows/networking environment using Windows Server 2003/2008R/2012R2 and Windows 7/8 operating systems.
- Provide services and support for an Apple environment using OSX 10.8/9/10.
- Provide services and support with respect to: devices using iOS and Android operating systems, Exchange Server 2010/2013, Group Policy, Active Directory.
- Perform network communication systems support (e.g. switches, routers, TCP/IP, Firewalls and Networking).
- Provide help desk support of OTUSA and ACEA users.
- Roll-out IT equipment and business applications (Google Apps for business) to new OTUSA and ACEA users.
- Provide on-site support (including IT hardware installation) at the America's Cup event venues as required by OTUSA and ACEA.
- Assist in the management of OTUSA's and ACEA's IT assets.
- Such other duties as reasonably required by OTUSA and ACEA for the successful performance of the role.

About the America's Cup:

The America's Cup is the oldest trophy in international sport and the preeminent international sailing competition. Initially a one-on-one competition between teams representing the nations of their respective yacht clubs, the America's Cup has evolved into a multi-team competition featuring the best sailors in the world on the world's fastest and most innovative boats – wing-sailed and foiling AC45 and AC62 catamarans.

The 35th America's Cup begins in 2015 and 2016 with the America's Cup World Series, raced in venues around the world. This feeds into the main events in 2017, which will narrow the field to just two: the top challenger and the defender, ORACLE TEAM USA, who will then face each other in the 35th America's Cup Match in Bermuda in the summer of 2017.
